Queen Elizabeth's School has very high standards of uniform and we wish all students to be able to meet those expectations. We understand that purchasing the correct uniform for your child is important. We also understand that it can be expensive. Unlike some Local Education Authorities, Dorset does not provide financial assistance for clothing. Therefore as a school we will consider providing clothing support on an individual basis. If the child in question is entitled to free school meals the school will offer:

Blazer
Shirt or Blouse x2
Tie – boys only
A pair of trousers or a skirt

PE Top
PE Tech Top (long sleeve)
PE Shorts or PE Leggings
PE Blue socks

This support will normally be available for pupils once in year 9 or 10. Support will not be given in consecutive years. In year 11 considerations will be dependent on adequate funds being available.
